NDC CENTRAL REGION BARES TEETH AT WINNEBA DIVISIONAL COMMANDER ACP JEFFREY DARKO OVER EFFUTU CONSTITUENCY

The National Democratic Congress in the Central Region has become aware of the tensions and happenings in the Effutu constituency which is affecting the morale of our comrades in the Effutu Constituency. Of particular interest is the Winneba Divisional Commander ACP Jeffrey Darko who as a divisional commander of the Ghana Police Service should be seen to be pushing the interest of all people of Effutu Constituency in order to ease tensions and ensure peace and tranquility ahead of the December elections. His selective justice and intimidation of our members has reached a crescendo where we will no longer sit back and watch gleefully while he goes on an intimidation spree under the orders of MP Afenyo Markins and the MCE.

Just a fortnight ago, ACP Darko despite reports from our PC and party members about the destruction to our party billboards chose to provide security to MP Afenyo's billboards and looked on whenever the billboards of our Flagbearer and PC are destroyed by the MCEs thugs. This intimidation will not be tolerated any longer and so we wish to serve notice to the IGP Dr Dampare, that we the NDC in the Central Region will no longer sit back and watch on while our billboards and posters are destroyed.

We wish to express our gross disaffection with the handling of the matter by the Divisional Commander ACP Jeffery Darko, and wish to notify him, the Effutu Assembly and the constituents, about the facial presence of a former president of Ghana on the billboards. We have also taken notice of the selective surveillance of NPP billboards and abandonment of those that belong to the NDC and will advise ourselves appropriately.

Ghanaians and the good people of Effutu constituency have been impoverished by the current NPP administration, due to the economic mismanagement, high rates of corruption and nepotism, destruction of our democratic gains through widespread manipulation of neutral constitutional bodies, among others and needs a rescuer.

We wish to ask the voters in the region to vote massively against the NPP for heightening tensions in the region and destabilizing peaceful coexistence. The peace that existed before, during and after the 2016 general elections must manifest itself as we head into the 7th December 2024, and no amount of intimidations can stop us from winning the Effutu seat and to Reset Ghana.
